

PUBLIC HEARING - LOCAL LAW 4 OF THE YEAR 2010 - DECEMBER 13, 2010

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held by the Town of Preble Town Board on Monday December 13, 2010, at 7:45 p.m. at the Town Hall to consider enactment of Local Law 4 of 2010 which would provide for the licensing and control of dogs in the Town of Preble..

Any resident of the Town of Preble is entitled to be heard upon said local law at such public hearing. Copies of said proposed local law are available for review at the Town Clerk's Office.

On Monday, December 13, 2010, the Preble Town Board held a public hearing on Local Law 4 for 2011, a local law which provides for the licensing and control of dogs . The meeting was opened by Supervisor, James Doring, at 7:56 pm. The public notice was read.

Supervisor Doring asked for comments from the floor.

Lindsay Kemp is questioning (1) Section 11D - Change to - **Any dog unredeemed after a seven (7) day redemption period shall be made available for adoption or euthanized.**

(2) Section 6: A5 - Change to **The Town of Preble does not allow the licensing of dogs by a shelter. A shelter must send the adoptive dog owners to the Town Clerk of the Town of City in which the dog will be harbored for licensing, however, application may be accepted and processed by any shelter duly authorized by the Town Board by resolution.**

Motion made by Tom Fox to close the public hearing, seconded by Debra Brock; all in favor; public hearing closed at 8:08.
