

SPECIAL MEETING - April 30, 2012

Evaluating the application of Suit-Kote Corp. for an aquifer protection permit

LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special meeting will be held by the Preble Town Board at 8:00 pm on April 30, 2012, at the Preble Town Hall, Preble, New York, for the purpose of evaluating the application of Suit-Kote Corp. for an aquifer protection permit with regard to premises located at 2188, 2192 Thomas Albert Drive in the Town and making a decision thereon.

Residents of the Town of Preble are invited to attend the meeting.

The Special Meeting was opened at 8:00 p.m. by Peter Knapp, Deputy Supervisor. In Supervisor Doring's absence.

Board members present: Debra Brock, Dave Morse and Linda Riehlman

Others attending: Ryan DuBois, Paul Suits and Kevin Bernstein representing Suit-Kote; Betty Ann Pitman Ken Brock, Tim Coyne and Jim Harris

Patrick Snyder, attorney for the Suit-Kote project, commented that the Stormwater Permit is not a separate permit but is a general permit which exists already. He also stated that the Planning Board has approved the site plan with 2 changes: 1)the waste water will be taken care by a closed loop system, and 2) the DEC will monitor the wells.

At Debra Brock's recommendation, copies of all permits issued by other agencies which will include a copy of the DEC Stormwater Permit, and copies of registrations should be kept on file at the Town Clerk's Office. Rick Fritz, Code Enforcement Officer, will be doing inspections.

Debra Brock invited Suit-Kote to join the town in the town's efforts to fulfill the requirements of the Central New York Regional Planning Board's Climate Change Innovation Program.

Deputy Supervisor Knapp thanked Attorney Patrick Snyder for all his help in this project and the officials from Suit-Kote for their time and efforts.

Paul Suits of Suit-Kote thanked all the Town Boards for their help and made the comment that their lines are always open if there are any questions.
