Said Local Law, if enacted, will ensure that outdoor wood boilers are utilized in a manner that does not create a nuisance and in recognition of the impact that outdoor wood boilers have on the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Preble. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Town Board will hold a public hearing on the proposed Local Law at the said Town offices on January 11, 2016 at 7:55 or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at which time all persons interested will be heard.
